Technology in classrooms - Scaling successful practices

OLE Nepal (Open Learning Exchange Nepal) is hosting an international conference on “**Shaping the Future of Learning**” on November 7-10, 2017 as part of its 10th year anniversary. The conference in Kathmandu will bring together groups and organizations from all around the world who have been using technology to improve the quality of education and to promote equitable access to better learning opportunities to children from all backgrounds. The four-day event will provide a platform for practitioners to share their experiences, lessons and challenges, and hold discussions with other groups, experts, policymakers, teachers and learners to develop strategies to scale successful practices to help shape the future of learning around the world.

Participants will visit schools to observe technology-integrated classes and interact with students and teachers; listen to implementers present on good practices around the world; watch panels of experts, academics, policymakers and educators discuss on the merits and challenges of scaling successful innovative practices; and deliberate on how best to leverage technology and innovations to provide meaningful opportunities to millions of children who are still deprived of their right to quality education.
